✓ Please Do

-  Try to arrive before class begins to allow your child to transition to the classroom.
-  Participate in class by singing and dancing with your child and the other families.
-  Feel free to act as silly as you like.
-  Take back home what you learn in class.
-  Listen to the recordings at home and in the car.
-  Notify us beforehand if you need to bring an unregistered sibling to class.
-  Have fun!

⊘ Please Don't

-  Chat with your neighbors in class. Use class time to play musically with your child.
-  Talk on your cell phone, check your e-mail, or send text messages in class.
-  Take photos or videos during class time, because it distracts the children from the musical activities. However, we welcome the taking of pictures before or after class.
-  Feed your child in the classroom. Bottles and secure sippy cups may be used if absolutely necessary, but no juice boxes.
-  Bring a child with fever, a rash, a hacking cough, a streaming nose, oozing eyes, or lice or nits to class. If you are in doubt, please consult your child's doctor.
-  Bring unregistered children other than siblings to class. Free demo classes are offered before each semester begins for families who would like to try out a class.
